

## CITIZEN GOVERNMENT REVIEW COMMITTEE RULES OF THE COMMITTEE

- In any case where Committee rules do not apply, Robert's Rules of Order Revised shall govern.
- The Chair shall preserve order and decorum, prevent attacks on personalities or the impugning of member's motives, and confine members in debate to the question under discussion.
- 3. The Chair, in working with staff and the other members of the Committee, shall determine the final agenda, including scheduling and order of business.
- 4. During Public Comment, each member of the public shall be granted 4 minutes to speak.

  Any extension of time is allowed by majority vote of the Committee.
- 5. All presentations submitted before the Committee shall be no longer than 20 minutes.

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- 6. Committee members may ask questions of staff or any individuals presenting or speaking to the Committee, once they have been recognized.
- 7. Questions and discussion shall be limited to the subject matter on the agenda for the day, except as otherwise allowed by the Chair.
- 8. Staff will not address presenters or individuals speaking to the Committee without being recognized by the Chair.

- 9. Committee members may choose to attend committee meetings in person or by virtual application.
- 10. In the absence of the Chair during any Committee meeting, the Vice Chair shall take over the duties of the Chair.
