#### Welcome

- Community Events Planning: Director Glaude' emphasized the importance of community events and highlighted the necessity for a community needs assessment survey, encouraging the HRC to conduct one in 2025. A sample survey was provided to the members present for their review.
- Innovative Engagement Activities: Director Glaude' and Zaynah provided a list of activities the HRC can do for 2025. Members present were provided with the list of activities.
- **Bridging Gaps Exercise:** The Community Engagement and DEI Team led the Bridging Gaps Exercise. This exercise began with an open discussion, which then transitioned into smaller group discussions aimed at identifying gaps in the Topeka community. The session lasted 45 minutes and concluded with presentations from each small group. Ongoing discussions and the next steps for the exercise will take place during the February HRC Meeting.

**Q & A/Open Discussion:** Members of the HRC asked Director Glaude' about the next steps following the retreat. She shared that the Commissioners will need to decide how to proceed based on the discussions held and the information provided by staff. When asked about the future of the DEI office, she mentioned the potential merger of the DEI and the Office of Community Engagement, stating that Taff is still awaiting direction from leadership.
